A. TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN UPDATE

- i. Public Works Director Dustin Johnson states they did receive some feedback from the public regarding the Transportation Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) and the list of projects has been compiled. He said the list has not changed very much since the last time the list was posted but it is once again available and out for public comment. Staff will be meeting with the public at a town hall meeting to allow for dialogue with citizens regarding the CIP. Once the comment period closes in February, the comments will be taken to City Council. Mr. Randall asks how the public will know comments are available and about the town hall meeting. Mr. Johnson states a press release was put out which will be on the City's website, social media, and will be in the newspaper. Mr. Havens asks if the new City Council and Mayor have been informed about this comment period. He states he does not believe they have specifically been updated about it as there is a lot of information to provide to them. Mr. Randall states he believes it would be a good idea for Mr. Johnson to inform them in writing and Mr. Johnson states he agrees and this is a perfect time to discuss transportation since there is a new Mayor and City Council. Mr. Randall also suggests City Council specifically be invited to the town hall which Mr. Johnson states he will do. Mr. Randall thanks Mr. Johnson for his update. Mr. Johnson states he will have another update for February's DAC meeting.

- B. Mr. Havens states in the past DAC has discussed having Department Directors attending meetings to provide information about how they accommodate individuals with disabilities. He states it would be great to hear from Transit, Library, Parks and Recreation, and Human Resources. Ms. Province states she would be happy to present at a meeting on personnel related accommodations and will also reach out to the other departments about presenting. Mr. Randall suggests one staff presentation per quarter.
